Route Information

Five route options are offered to fit riders of all abilities. We have 10, 24, 40, 60, and 75 mile available routes. The routes are clearly marked and all are on hard surfaced roads. Changed just slightly from 2012 the 2013 routes you will still travel through the areas of Burnside, Disco, LaHarpe, Nauvoo, Niota and the beautiful area known as "Happy Hollow", offering outstanding river and woodland views along the way. One of the most scenic sections of the 75 mile route is a portion of the Great River Road south of Nauvoo where the tree lined road is just yards from the mighty Mississippi River as it curves along Illinois. Beautiful bluffs tower over the byway as permanent sentinels for the great river.

Whether directly along the banks of the river, or winding through the hills and hollows, Hancock County presents its own flavor through its wildlife, farmland, and four centuries of history and heritage.



Registration Information

Everyone registering by September 12th gets a "Rode Outta Town for the Sheriff" t-shirt. Registrations received after September 12th will not get a t-shirt, but shirts will be available for purchase at the registration table at a cost of \$15.00 each. Availability of the t-shirts may be limited, so register early.
