

## BUILDING AND GROUNDS COMMITTEE

The Building and Grounds Committee met in the County Board Committee met in the County Board Room on January 11, 2016 at 6:30pm. Members present were Tom Scheetz, Chairman, Bryan Stevens, Jan Fleming, Jerry Smith, Harold Stuckwisch, Mark Hanson, Dennis Castlebury and Cary Gray, County Board Chairman.

Sheriff Scott Bentzinger entered the meeting and informed the members that he has twenty four inmates and seventeen are male and seven are female. Scott also informed the members that he is waiting for the Contract from the Labor Committee and he will check it over to make sure it is correct. He also stated that the Charger is gone and Carson will get the replacement ready. Scott is going to give Carson's the check for the Insurance money and they will pay Greenfield for the other vehicle.

Thirty-nine claims were reviewed for payment by the members. After reviewing a motion was made by Harold Stuckwisch to present the claims to the full board for payment. Jerry Smith seconded the motion. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Tom informed the members that we have hopefully settled the Labor dispute and they did agree to two years at 2 1/2% and they want a Health Saving Plan. They would also like to work ten or twelve hour days.

Tom also stated that he had talked to CIRMA and they put him in touch with a gentleman that has a group health insurance plan with several counties. Tom would like to have this gentleman to come and talk to us about this and maybe we can get our County Health Insurance with this group and at a cheaper rate.

Tom also discussed the ambulance building with the members and several things were discussed but as it was stated we have already voted on purchasing the building and site.

Tom also stated that he saw where Mr. Richardson the former EMT Director was sentence.

The total claims paid for this committee was \$13,276.32

Having nothing further to discuss a motion was made by Harold Stuckwisch to recess until February 8, 2016 at 6:30pm. Dennis Castlebury seconded the motion. All voted aye. Motion carried
