

## Committee for EMS Director

After everyone read the job description a motion was made by Bryan Stevens to accept it with the change of preferred bachelor's degree. Mark Hanson seconded the motion. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Th members then discussed if this should be a full-time position and what they should offer for a salary range. You have to figures if it is a benefit package deal, the retirement, insurance and paid holidays. Mark Menn stated to promote this as a full-time position with the benefit package or retirement, insurance and paid holidays with a range of \$40,000.00 to \$50,00.00. Bryan Stevens seconded the motion. All voted aye.

The members discussed setting a calendar of when to interview.
