


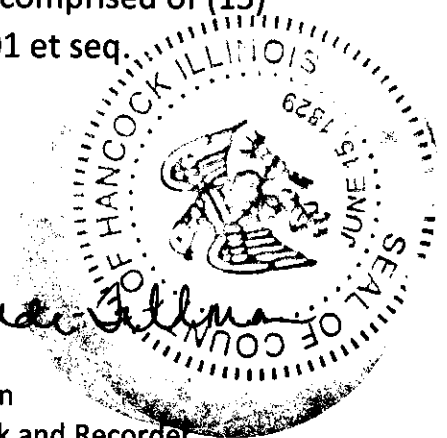
## NOTICE

**NOTIC IS HEREBY GIVEN** that a hearing of the County Board of the County of Hancock, State of Illinois, will be held in the County Board Room, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Courthouse, 500 Main Street, Carthage, Illinois 62321 on Tuesday, July 13<sup>th</sup> at 6:15 p.m.

The hearing was called to address the reapportionment according to the estimated survey data by the American Community Survey. Hancock County has a population under 3,000,000 and has township form of government, and the County Board has determined its members shall be elected by multi-member districts, and apportionment plan has been developed by the County Board specifying the number of districts, five (5), which are comprised of contiguous territory as nearly compact practicable, and each district to have three (3) members elected therefrom, so that the County Board will be comprised of (15) members, all within the meaning of 55 ILCS Division 2-3, 2-3001 et seq.
